If you are at least 18-years old and concerned about a friend, family member or an associate with an opioid addiction, this 2-hour training is for you.

Naloxone is a prescription medication that reverses the affects of an opioid overdose. Participants who successfully complete the training will receive a certificate for the use of Naloxone and a **FREE** Naloxone kit. Tips on overdose prevention and resources detailing local and national resources will also be provided to participants.
