**Base Funding:** \$1,087,701 **Competitive Funding:** \$439,468

**Board Support:** \$330,000

**Creating Healthy Bonds** - Ensures that the parents of Montgomery County children will have the ability to stay in contact and communication with their children during the course of their incarceration. Creating Healthy Bonds will bring together services from each provider in an effort to wrap families with an array of service delivery and provision meant to address their unique and individual needs. \$107,701

**Peer Bridges** - Provides navigation services to disconnected youth who are ages 16 to 24 and their families, with a focus on disconnected youth with behavioral health challenges, with an emphasis on engaging African American and Latino youth and young parents who are disconnected. \$60,000

**Excel Beyond the Bell** - A collaborative effort to develop a County-wide system of out-of-school time (OST) opportunities for youth. It includes OST at eight middle schools and a comprehensive system of professional development. The intent is to inspire youth to realize their full potential within a sustainable system of safe, quality, and accessible programs. \$172,800

**Youth Development Community of Practice** - To strengthen the practice of youth development practitioners and ultimately improve outcomes for youth, the Local Management Board will establish a Youth Development Community of Practice (CoP) infrastructure for practitioners serving youth who are disconnected from school and work. \$317,200

**Safe Space** - Outreach services and physical space supported with intensive re-education and re-engagement programming that addresses trauma focused needs, for disconnected youth to gather in the community, made available from 6 pm to 12 am on Friday and Saturday nights. \$100,000

**Competitive Award:** Re-engagement Center - Based on a nationally proven, evidence-based model to effectively reach disconnected youth and to reconnect them for the long-term. This center will serve as a hub where disconnected youths in the East Central and Southeast Montgomery County can receive essential services that will help them re-engage in education and workforce activities, and to have the opportunity to lead productive and meaningful lives. \$439,468
